**LIST OF UNANSWERED QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES BY THE COMMISSION**

<b>No.</b>	<b>Question</b>	<b>Commission`s response</b>
1	Can an organisation from the UK participate as a coordinating beneficiary in a LIFE+ Nature project that will take place in Romania (either in partnership with an associated beneficiary from Romania or alone)? Can you please answer the question also for the other components of LIFE+?	Yes, either in partnership or alone, for all three components. Note, however, that LIFE+ beneficiaries must submit their proposals to the competent national authority of the Member State in which the coordinating beneficiary is registered, while the support of the competent authority, if required, concerns the Member State where the actions take place.
2	Would land donation (e.g., transfer of ownership) be eligible (count) as co-funding?	No. This would be considered as an in-kind contribution, i.e., without cash transaction.
3	Can a LIFE+ project be implemented on a privately owned land?	Yes, if the necessary guarantees in terms of sustainability of results are provided.
4	Can a project be implemented on a part of a Natura 2000 site rather than the whole area?	Yes. It is often the case.
