



A8 Form Procedure (Nature and Biodiversity Proposals ONLY)

1. Send the proposal summary (forms **B1** and **B2**) and A8 form to the correct competent authority by **14th July 2010**.

2. Competent Authority signs A8 form and sends back to coordinating beneficiary.

3. Coordinating beneficiary sends final proposal (including the signed A8 form) to Beta Technology for final submission deadline - **1st September 2010**.

4. Beta Technology carries out eligibility checks on the full proposal. If there are any problems with the proposal, the applicant is given a further 5 working days to make the recommended changes.
